BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared the undersigned affiant who, after being duly sworn by me, on oath stated:

My name is J. LUKER #984, and I am a peace officer of the City of Irving, Dallas County, Texas.

I have good reason to believe and do believe that on or about the 04th day of January, 2015, one HAVENS, MARK, did then and there in the City of Irving, Dallas County, Texas commit the offense of MANUFACTURE/DELIVER CS PG 2 >=400 g, a violation of section 481.113(e), Texas HEALTH & SAFETY CODE, a 1st DEGREE FELONY - **Agg**

My belief is based upon the following facts and information:

WILHELM, COREY #1013, Officer, Irving Police Department, who participated in the investigation of the alleged offense, furnished to me, the Affiant, on 03-03-15, the following information:

On January 4th, 2015 your affiant, Inv. Wilhelm #1013 and the Irving Police Narcotics Section executed a search warrant at 2806 West Walnut Hill Lane, Irving, Dallas County, Texas. The Defendant, Mark Havens, was not at the location. A search of the location revealed 572.53g of Hashish Oil, 1,533.39g of marijuana, a Smith & Wesson 9mm pistol, a Taurus .22 caliber pistol, and several drug paraphernalia items. Lab results were received on the Hashish Oil and Marijuana from the Southwestern Institute of Forensic Sciences at Dallas on January 29th, 2015 with positive results. Based on the amount of hashish oil found being that of a much larger quantity than a common user the defendant is being charged with manufacture/delivery controlled substance penalty group 2 under 400 grams and possession of marijuana under 5 pounds. This case is being filed at large.
