

The following is not allowed on the bandsaw. Cutting logs without support is very dangerous, the logs can spin up or roll potentially resulting in damaging the blade or machine and can result in serious personal injury.



Cutting with a cradle or jig is allowed (makes sure you do not cut any screws used to hold the 2x4 to the plywood). The cradle/jig provide support for the log and will prevent spinning/rolling. Note: DMS does not provide cradles or jigs – you need to make your own. The jig is based on a design found in Wood Magazine
